Born in Nam Dinh, North Vietnam, and immigrated to the South when The Geneva Agreement was signed on July 20th, 1954.

- Graduated from Chu Van An High School in 1965.
- Bachelor of Arts (1966-1970).

Attending the Faculty of Letters and simultaneously worked for the US 7th Air Force in Tan Son Nhat air base, Saigon for five years when recruited to work for the US Embassy in Saigon from 1970 to 1975.

After the Fall of Saigon on April 30th, 1975, was imprisoned for a total of 17 years. Released on April 29th, 1992, and allowed to go to America under the Humanitarian Operation (H.O.) Program on August 3rd, 1993.

Worked for The VNCOC in Orange County, California, and other staffing agencies from 1994 to 2009.

Retired in 2010 to write Memoirs "The Last Prisoners" and to work P/T with some Vietnamese newspapers and media.
