The children education is very important ,should be the priority we have to concern

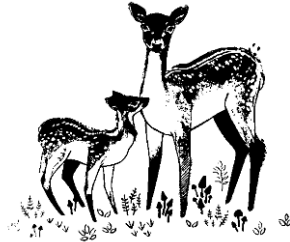

HEAD AND TAIL OF THE SNAKE

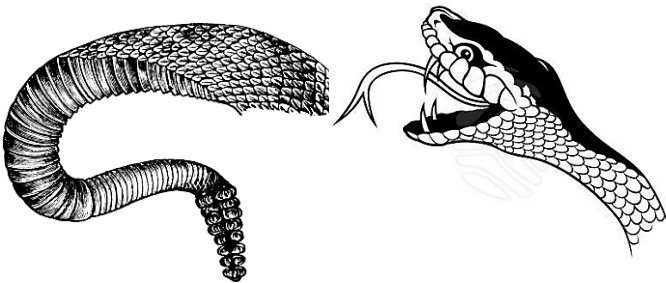
The snake's tail had a fight with its head. The tail said, " You led me for so long. Now it's time for me to lead you"

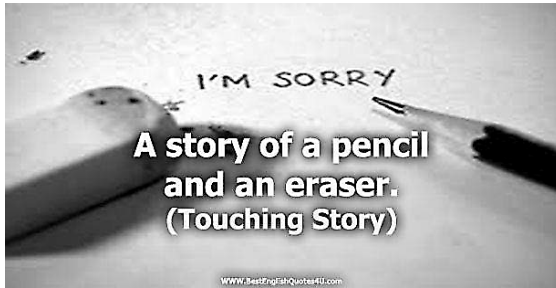
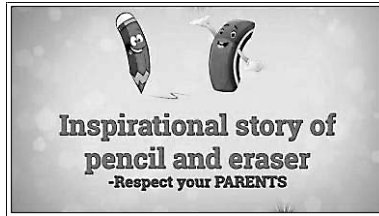
THE 11 TH STORY

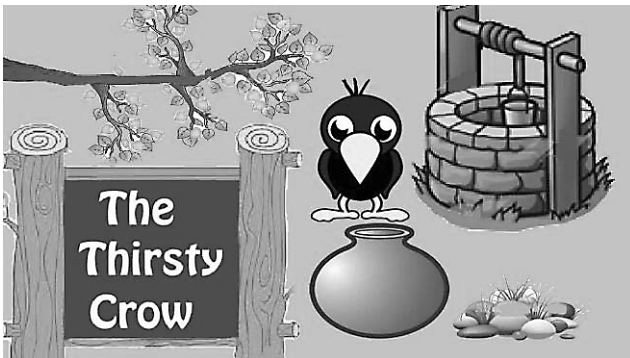

THE GREEDY DOG

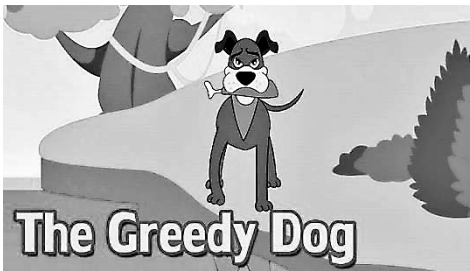
This is story of a stray dog who used to roam street to street in search of food and water.

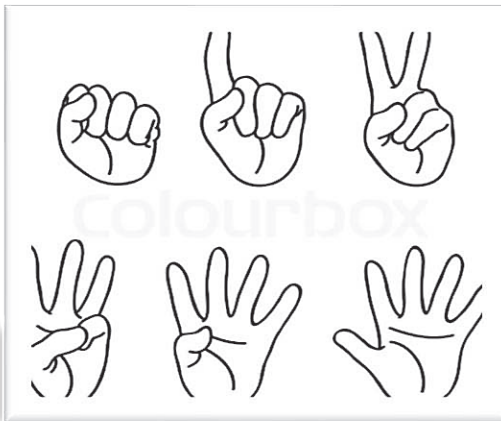

Please do not get so busy that you let them think you have forgotten them", said the elderly man. And with that he turned and walk hopelessly out of the store

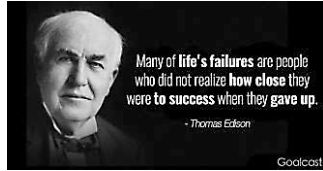

BIRD AND THE BANYAN TREE

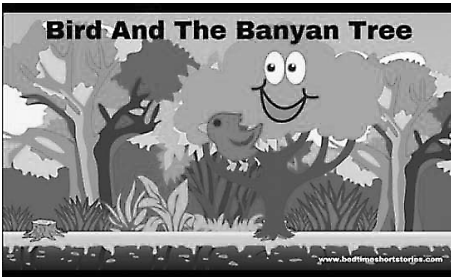

As Howard Kelly left that house he not only felt strong physically but also his faith in God and human was strengthened.

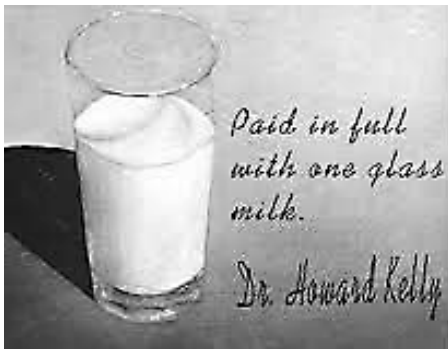

MORAL: You should be observant, talk less but listen more. This will make you a wise person.

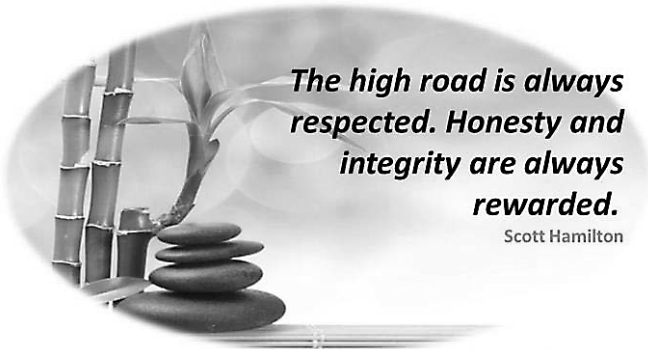

THE SILENT HERO NICHOLAS WINTON

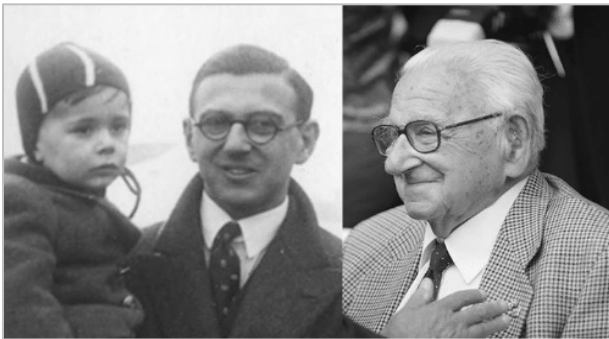

A TOWN MOUSE AND A COUNTRY MOUSE

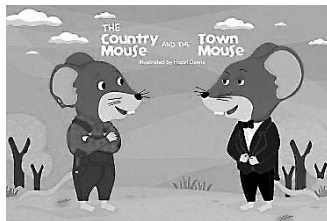
Once there were two mice. One lived in country and the other in a town. One day, the country mouse invited the town mouse to dine with him and served him the best food

THE MAN WITH 4 WIVES

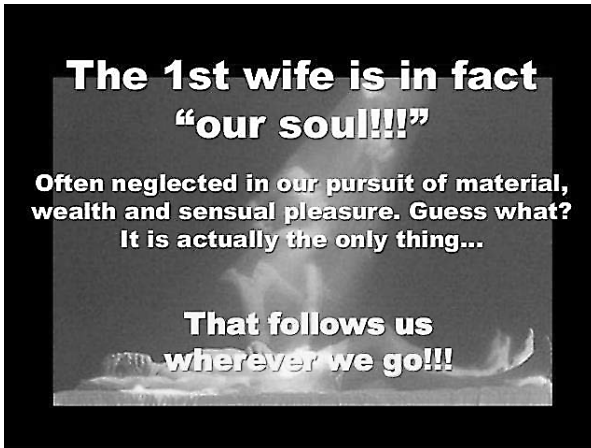
